





With decades of experience in personal computing and Al, the speaker will reflect on how early innovations, like text-to-speech, have evolved into today's Al integration in the workforce. As we advance, we must heed the balance between excitement and caution, responsibly harnessing Al's potential while heeding warnings, like those of Elon Musk, about its risks.


